COMING SOUTH ON ROUTE 26:

You never leave it until you reach the church. Approaching East Main St. in Endicott, you will pass under a railroad bridge and probably get a red light. Be sure to get into the left hand lane as soon as you clear the light, as the next light is Main St. Actually there is no Main St., only West Main St. and East Main St. Turn left, and you will be on East Main St., still Rte. 26. An Eckerd Drugstore is on your right, as is the church in the next block. Please go to the paragraph on parking lots.

ARRIVING BY RTE. 17, SOON TO BECOME I86:

Either east or west, get off at the Endicott ramp, exit 67 north. You will now be on Rte. 26. Get in the middle lane. The right lane will take you to Binghamton, which is a very nice little city, but you're not going there. The left lane will get you into the heart of Endicott, which is closer, but you may get lost. Follow the middle lane, which makes a 270 degree turn to the right. You are now on Rte. 26 yet, and headed in the right direction. There are four red lights to go through, and with my luck, there will be four red lights.

When you see a Friendly's restaurant, you're looking in the wrong direction. The church is on the left. Please go to the paragraph on parking lots.

PLANNING TO USE RTE. 434:

Don't! Friday afternoon and early evening boasts a regular parade of traffic putting a new meaning to the oxymoron "rush hour". If you insist however, take the Endicott exit which puts you onto Rte. 26 north. Follow the directions of those more fortunate who elected to use Rte. 17.

PARKING LOTS:

Assuming you have arrived at your destination, or in Presbyterianeeze, your predestination, the parking lot at Liberty Ave. has two handicap parking slots. The lot at Loder Ave. does not, even though it may indicate so. Maybe by September we can get the signs removed. Be a bit careful on entering Liberty Ave., as the entrances were originally driveways of two rather dilapidated houses we purchased and razed. They are not quite right for the traffic pattern. You are welcome to use either lot, but you can't sneak in without paying the \$5.00. Registration and acceptance of moneys will be handled at both entrances. Those who would rather not or can't climb stairs should use the Liberty St. lot as there is an elevator inside that entrance.
