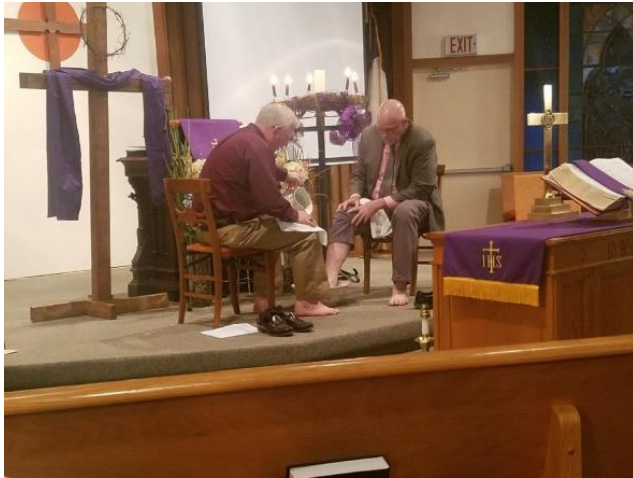


## United Presbyterian Church of Cincinnatus



We don't consider ourselves a small church, but a blessed church! Our 50 members are engaged in all three "legs" of this community of faith: worship, service, and learning. We serve our community through a variety of events and in supporting the mission of Cortland – Chenango Rural Services. We enjoy spending time in Bible study and our monthly "Soup & Scripture" where we talk about upcoming lectionary readings and possible sermon approaches to those readings. We enjoy, are fed by, and strengthened through our worship services. We also join with our brothers and sisters from eight other local churches through the Otselic Valley Church Alliance worshipping together each Sunday afternoon during Lent and on other special Sundays throughout the year.

This past week, we joined with the congregation of Onondaga Hill Presbyterian Church in Syracuse (the home church of our CLP George Carruth) in joint worship on Maundy Thursday in Cincinnatus and on Good Friday at OHPC. The choirs were combined for two very moving anthems and members from both congregations participated in the liturgies. On Thursday Pastor George and Pastor Bob led us through a symbolic "Washing of the feet" ceremony and an observance of the Last Supper, including the stripping of the sanctuary. On Friday we explored together the impact of Good Friday on those who were eye-witnesses to the events that day as part of a Tenebrae service.

We face the same challenges as all other "small" church but refuse to categorize our self as "small". We are a people with big hearts, big ideas, and a big commitment to our faith, to our community, and to our God. We pray that the Holy Spirit will lead us and guide us on the paths God would have us travel together into our future.

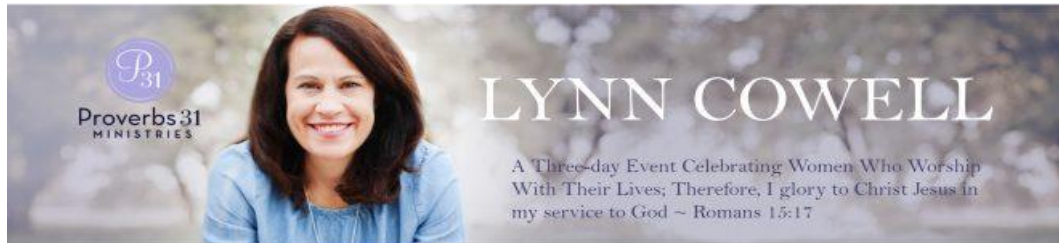
